

WHEN HIS PURPOSE SHALL BE ACCOMPLISHED



INTRODUCTION: Philippians 3:20-21

"But **our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there**, the Lord Jesus Christ, who , by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, **will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body.**"

"Never can the cost of our redemption be realized **until the redeemed shall stand with the Redeemer before the throne of God.** Then as the glories of the eternal home burst upon our enraptured senses we shall remember that Jesus left all this for us, that He not only became an exile from the heavenly courts, **but for us took the risk of failure and eternal loss.** Then we shall cast our crowns at His feet, and raise the song, 'Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory, and blessing.' Revelation 5:12."(DA 131.2)

OBJECTIVES:

In this lesson we shall endeavor to study God's plan for the creation of both this world and man himself. We will try to answer these questions: Will there be marriages and births in the afterlife? If yes, why? Is God planning to create more Angels? Why does/will Satan war against the remnant of God's people? Did God create more than one World? What's your duty In the Story of Redemption?

Let's begin our study by looking at

THE SONS OF GOD - The Angelic beings :Job 38:4-7(NKJV)

Asks the LORD, "Where were you when I laid the foundations of the earth? Tell Me, if you have understanding. **Who determined its measurements?** Surely you know! Or who stretched the line upon it? To what were its foundations fastened? Or **who laid its cornerstone, When the morning stars sang together, And all the sons of God shouted for joy?"**

The **morning stars** and the **sons of God**, according to this scripture, though not eternal **existed at least before the creation of the earth**, for when the earth was created, **they sang and shouted for joy**. We know that stars represent the angels(Rev 12:4).

The sons of God also represent the angels in certain places like here, for no human being existed at that time of the earth's creation (compare with GC 518). In fact the New International Version even uses the term "**angels**" instead of the phrase "**sons of God**". It reads,

“...while the morning stars sang together and all the angels shouted for joy?”(Job 38:7)

Even though this is the case, the phrase "**sons of God**" does not always represent the angels, like in Genesis 6:1-2 where the "**sons of God**" were the **descendants of Seth**, and in 1 John 3:1 where the **believers are called by that name**. Having thus established the fact that these angelic beings were created before the creation of the world, let's look at,

THE HEAVENLY COUNCIL Job 1:6,2:1

"Now there was a day **when the sons of God came to present themselves before the Lord**, and Satan also came among them."

"**Again** there was a day **when the sons of God came to present themselves before the Lord**, and Satan came also among them **to present himself before the Lord.**"

The fact that the sons of God came to present themselves before the Lord shows that **these angelic beings do not**

always dwell in the presence of the Lord, otherwise it cannot be said that they came to present themselves before the Lord, at least twice. That Satan also came among them from somewhere else even proves this fact, also that these angelic beings **might have come from somewhere else**.

When Jesus ascended to heaven, the record is..

"All heaven was waiting to welcome the Saviour to the celestial courts. **As He ascended**, He led the way, and the multitude of captives set free at His resurrection followed. The heavenly host, with shouts and acclamations of praise and celestial song, attended the joyous train. As they drew near to the city of God, the challenge is given **by the escorting angels**...Then the portals of the city of God are opened wide, and **the angelic throng sweep through the gates amid a burst of rapturous music**. There is the throne, and around it the rainbow of promise. There are cherubim and seraphim. **The commanders of the angel hosts, the sons of God, the representatives of the unfallen worlds , are assembled**. The heavenly council

before which Lucifer had accused God and His Son, **the representatives of those sinless realms** over which Satan had thought to establish his dominion, — **all are there to welcome the Redeemer**. They are eager to celebrate His triumph and to glorify their King."(DA 833, 834)

Notice that The angelic throng was with Jesus , escorting Him from the earth, when this heavenly council was set. Those sons of God(angelic beings), **otherwise termed the representatives of the unfallen worlds** came from somewhere else (from the unfallen worlds) and they were there to welcome the Redeemer.

These are also clearly distinguished from the Cherubim and Seraphim. This shows that whenever the Lord wants something more important to be done, he calls for a meeting. Yes, the heavenly council is set to decide over those matters.(PP 35.3). The Presence of these representatives of the unfallen worlds shows that **there are other worlds which have never fallen like the earth**. That these are the sons of God in Job 1:6 and 2:1 cannot

be mistaken. The question naturally arises,

DID GOD CREATE MORE THAN ONE WORLD?

Let no one doubt the power of the Almighty. In scripture, we are told that,

"For by Him **all things were created** that are in heaven and that are on earth, **visible and invisible**, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him."(Colossians 1:16)

Evidently, then, just because you can't see something doesn't necessarily mean that it doesn't exist. The statement "**rejoice, O Heavens, and you who dwell in them**"(Revelation 12:12), shows that beside One heaven, where God dwells, there are **other heavens** with inhabitants in them. And as the term "heaven" is actually the firmament, otherwise called atmosphere(Genesis 1:6-8), the truth is clear that there are many worlds, each having its own heaven(atmosphere). This same truth is

confirmed when the Bible says that God created the **"worlds"**(Hebrews 1:2,11:3).

Inspiration also confirms this same truth in the following manner...

"The Lord has given me a view of other worlds. Wings were given me, and an angel attended me from the city to a place that was bright and glorious. The grass of the place was living green, and the birds there warbled a sweet song. **The inhabitants of the place were of all sizes; they were noble, majestic, and lovely.** They bore the express image of Jesus, and their countenances beamed with holy joy, **expressive of the freedom and happiness of the place.** I asked one of them why they were so much more lovely **than those on the earth.** The reply was, 'We have lived in strict obedience to the commandments of God, and have not fallen by disobedience, like those on the earth.' Then I saw two trees, one looked much like the tree of life in the city. The fruit of both looked beautiful, but of one they could not eat. They had power to eat of both, but were forbidden to

eat of one. Then my attending angel said to me, 'None in this place have tasted of the forbidden tree; but if they should eat, they would fall.' **Then I was taken to a world which had seven moons.** There I saw good old Enoch, who had been translated. On his right arm he bore a glorious palm, and on each leaf was written 'Victory.' Around his head was a dazzling white wreath, and leaves on the wreath, and in the middle of each leaf was written 'Purity,' and around the wreath were stones of various colors, that shone brighter than the stars, and cast a reflection upon the letters and magnified them. On the back part of his head was a bow that confined the wreath, and upon the bow was written 'Holiness.' Above the wreath was a lovely crown that shone brighter than the sun. **I asked him if this was the place he was taken to from the earth.** He said, 'It is not; the city is my home, and I have come to visit this place.' He moved about the place as if perfectly at home. I begged of my attending angel to let me remain in that place. I could not bear the thought of coming back to this dark world again. Then the angel said, 'You must go back, and if you are faithful, you, **with the 144,000, shall have the privilege of visiting all the worlds**

and viewing the handiwork of God.””(EW 39.3)

There are many lessons which we learn from this: That God is so powerful that just by the Word of His Mouth He can create anything. **That just like Adam and Eve, the inhabitants of the unfallen worlds were also put under a test of obedience, and that they have never fallen like us on earth.** That by giving these beings freedom of choice, like the angels and men upon the earth, **God shows that He's not Dictatorial, but Democratic.** **That He is the God of Order and He governs the entire universe in Justice.** **That this is why there's the heavenly council,** where he assembles not only the angels of heaven, **but also the representatives of these unfallen worlds** to decide on certain matters.

But Why Did Satan come before God as a representative of the fallen World in the time of Job? **And Why was he not present on this Heavenly Council to welcome the Redeemer?**

ADAM, THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE HUMAM FAMILY.

Adam was made **a little lower than the angels of God**, and he **was crowned as king in Eden** over the whole Earth.(Psalms 8:3-8, 1BC 1082) **He was a representative of the Human family.**(PP 48.1). Now two of the reasons why Adam did not attend the Heavenly council to represent the Human family, and why Satan did it can be seen from the following perspectives..

1)Adam Was Put Under a Test and trial.

Remember that Adam **was not an angelic being** like those present in the heavenly council, **including Satan.** He was little lower than them. Inspiration says,

"The Father consulted His Son in regard to **at once** carrying out **their purpose** to make man to inhabit the earth. **He would place man upon probation to test his loyalty before he could be rendered eternally secure. If he endured the test wherewith God saw fit to prove him, he should eventually be equal with the angels** . He was to have the favor of God, and he was to converse with angels, and they with him. He did not see fit to place them

beyond the power of disobedience."(SR 19.2)

Thus, man was made a little lower than the angels, not equal with them for a special purpose. Indeed **the Lord did so to put him under the test and trial**. If he endured and overcame, **he would have been secured forever and would have become equal with the angels, ready to be part of the Heavenly council of angelic beings**. But he failed to overcome, thus allowed Satan to take this privilege from him.

2)Satan takes authority from Adam

"And the devil said to Him, 'All this authority I will give You, and their glory; **for this has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish**.'"(Luke 4:6).

Who delivered the glory and the kingdoms of the world to Satan? **Adam did, through disobedience**. This same fact is confirmed by Inspiration.(DA 129.4).

Thus Satan became the representative of the world, the

prince of the world, and presented himself before the heavenly council.

IT IS FINISHED

While it is true that Jesus came to save that which was lost(Matthew 18:11), it's also true that **He came to defeat Satan and his angels(Gen 3:15, Heb 2:14)**. When he said "it is finished"(John 19:30), he completely cast out Satan and brought his rulership to an end. From then onwards, Satan no longer had access to heaven.(John 12:31-33, Revelation 12:9-12, DA 834.3).

By Defeating Satan, Christ retrieved power and dominion from Satan and thus became the new representative of the Human family. Simultaneously, he was crowned as king of the kingdom of Grace. Thus he became the only Lawyer and Intercessor of man in the heavenly courts, indeed he became **the only mediator between God and Man**(1 Timothy 2:5).

"But we see Jesus, **who was made a little lower than the**

angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone."(Hebrews 2:9) Like Adam, Jesus was also made a little lower than the angels **in order to save man and become his representative. He became the second Adam.**(1 Corinthians 15:22,45)

Signs of the Times , January 16, 1896: “Jesus **humbled himself, clothing his divinity with humanity**, in order that he might stand **as the head and representative of the human family**, and by both precept and example condemn sin in the flesh, and give the lie to Satan's charges.”

When Jesus became our Representative in heaven, he commissioned his people to be His representatives on Earth(Matthew 28:19,20,Mark 16:15,16). **What have you done for Him? Are you His good Representative? Do you reflect His image in your life fully? Have you received the power of the Holy Spirit? Have you learned of His character? Are you overcoming sin? Are you separating yourself from the World?**

Remember that no sinner shall be permitted to enter heaven.

THE FALL OF LUCIFER AND THE CREATION OF MAN.

We cannot understand the actual origin of Sin. It is a mystery. But we know that when Satan campaigned against the government of God, he took a third of the angels with him. **The heavenly council sat and pleaded with him but he didn't listen,** therefore he was thrown out of heaven with his angels.

"Angels in heaven mourned the fate of those who had been their companions in happiness and bliss. Their loss was felt in heaven."(SR 19.1)

In view of the fact that **a huge gap was left in heaven** when Satan was thrown out with his angels, what did the Lord plan to do upon creating man? Why did the Lord say **“Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it.”**(Genesis 1:28) Here is what we need to understand:

"All heaven took a deep and joyful interest in the creation of the world and of man. Human beings were a new and distinct order. They were made 'in the image of God,' and it was the Creator's design that they should populate the earth. They were to live in close communion with heaven, receiving power from the Source of all power. Upheld by God, they were to live sinless lives."(1 SD 7.2)

"God created man for His own glory, that after test and trial the human family might become one with the heavenly family. It was God's purpose to re-populate heaven with the human family, if they would show themselves obedient to His every word. ."(The S.D.A. Bible Commentary 1:1082.4)

God designed that His people may, through procreation, populate the earth. But it was his purpose that heaven may be repopulated by human beings. In other words, He designed that the spaces left by Satan and his angels in heaven should be filled up by the human family, thus in addition to it being something that would lessen

loneliness, marriage was instituted by the Lord for reproduction. **But why are the principles of marriage and sex so perverted today? Why is it that many people today even in the Church have disregarded the sacredness of marriage? Why are young people today so obsessed with love and sex? Why is adultery and fornication so common today? Why do we have so many divorce cases? Has the Lord left the Earth?**

THOSE ACCOUNTED WORTHY TO OBTAINED THE KINGDOM OF GOD

Remember that the Lord's design was to make man equal with the angels after he had passed the test. Does that mean that this will never be accomplished since man sinned? What about repopulating the heavenly places with the human family? Even though Adam fell, those who will obtain the world to come must still pass the same test, overcoming flesh, sin and the world through the power of Christ.

"Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?"(1 John 5:5)

“He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God.” (Revelation 2:7)

Thus, the truth stands out that the promise is sure. Those who will overcome shall surely be made equal with the angels of God as He intended before. Not only that, Inspiration makes it very clear that the gaps left by Satan and his angels will be filled up by the Redeemed.

"The vacancies made in heaven by the fall of Satan and his angels will be filled by the redeemed of the Lord." (The Truth about Angels 49.1)

Thus, the purpose of the Lord to repopulate the heavenly family with the human family will be accomplished. And if that is a case, why should marriage and procreation continue to be there if all people will be like the angels who don't procreate, and all the vacancies will be filled up? It seems unlikely, the Holy Writ also

confirms this point:

"Jesus answered and said to them, **The sons of this age marry and are given in marriage** . But those who are counted worthy to attain that age, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry nor are given in marriage; **nor can they die anymore, for they are equal to the angels and are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection.**"(Luke 20:34-36)

"For **in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels of God in heaven.**"(Matthew 22:30)

"There are men today who express their belief **that there will be marriages and births in the new earth**; but those who believe the Scriptures cannot accept such doctrines. The doctrine that children will be born in the new earth is not a part of the 'sure word of prophecy' (2 Peter 1:19). **The words of Christ are too plain to be misunderstood** . They should forever settle the question of marriages and births in the new earth. **Neither those who shall be raised**

from the dead, nor those who shall be translated without seeing death, will marry or be given in marriage. They will be as the angels of God, members of the royal family."(1SM 172.3)

Thus, All the Redeemed (those who shall be raised from the dead and those who shall be translated without seeing death like the 144,000) will be like, as well as equal to, the angels of God in heaven. Also the fact that there shall be no marriages and births in the life to come cannot be dodged. The number of the Redeemed will be enough to fill up the spaces of the fallen angels, no need of having more children. The sad thing is that the people who have been privileged to attain that life and become equal to the angels of God are not doing what they should be doing. Many are resembling the character of demonic angels instead of the heavenly angels of light. When the Bridegroom comes, will your Robes be white and pure, washed in Christ's blood? Will your soul be ready to enter the mansions above?

THE TWO ADAMS MEET.

“As the ransomed ones are **welcomed to the city of God**, there rings out upon the air an exultant cry of adoration. **The two Adams are about to meet.** The Son of God is standing with outstretched arms to receive **the father of our race,—the being whom he created, who sinned against his Maker**, and for whose sin the marks of the crucifixion are borne upon the Saviour’s form. **As Adam** discerns the prints of the cruel nails, he does not fall upon the bosom of his Lord, but in humiliation casts himself at his feet, crying, **‘Worthy, worthy is the Lamb that was slain!’** Tenderly the Saviour lifts him up, **and bids him look once more upon the Eden home** from which he has so long been exiled. After his expulsion from Eden, Adam’s life on earth was filled with sorrow. Every dying leaf, every victim of sacrifice, every blight upon the fair face of nature, every stain upon man’s purity, was a fresh reminder of his sin. Terrible was the agony of remorse as he beheld iniquity abounding, and, in answer to his warnings, met the reproaches cast upon himself as the cause of sin. With patient humility he bore, for nearly a thousand years, the penalty of transgression. **Faithfully did he repent of his sin**, and trust in the merits of the

promised Saviour, and he died in the hope of a resurrection. The Son of God redeemed man's failure and fall, and now, through the work of the atonement, Adam is re-instated in his first dominion."(GC88 647.2.3)

Thus shall Adam be reinstated in his first dominion, and this shall he live with all the Redeemed forever, praising and worshipping the Saviour.

SATAN'S WARFARE AGAINST THE REMNANT.

Satan knows that the Redeemed will take his place and those of his angels. Do you think he can just allow it to happen especially that he has been cast out completely? He accuses them day and night.(Revelation 12:10)

“ ‘Are these,’ he says, ‘the people who are to take my place in heaven, and the place of the angels who united with me? They profess to obey the law of God; **but have they kept its precepts? Have they not been lovers of self more than lovers of God? Have they not placed their own interests above His service? Have they not loved the things of the world? Look at the sins that**

have marked their lives. Behold their selfishness, their malice, their hatred of one another. Will God banish me and my angels from His presence, and yet reward those who have been guilty of the same sins? Thou canst not do this, O Lord, in justice. Justice demands that sentence be pronounced against them.” (PK 588.3)

Thus, "...when the dragon saw that he had been cast to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male Child."(Revelation 12:13)

When Satan saw that he no longer had a place in heaven, and also failed to overcome Christ, he persecuted the people of God, **the Church, the woman**. This was seen in the persecution of the Church at Jerusalem(Acts 8:1). God's people ran away from Jerusalem in Israel to different parts of the world, otherwise termed "the wilderness"(Revelation 12:14). Satan did so in order to prevent them from overcoming sin and eventually be made equal with the angels of God and occupy the positions of the lost angels. He purposed to wipe out the Church from the face of the earth in anger. But the more

he killed the Christians, **the more they increased in numbers**. Seeing that this wasn't profiting him, he had to change the strategy.

"So the serpent spewed water out of his mouth like a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood."(Revelation 12:15)

In view of the fact that water represents "**.. peoples, multitudes, nations and tongues**"(Revelation 17:15), also that the water came from Satan's mouth, not from God's, the truth stands out that **these are the people of Satan sent to weaken and destroy the Church**. These are the Tares whose spiritual instability is capable of destroying the standards of Christianity. When Satan planted the Tares in the Church, **the Church lost her purity and stability**.(Matthew 13:24-30,38-39, GC88 384,385).

The fact that the Church since the death of the apostles has been moving from bad to worse shows that **there are many Tares in the Church that we can imagine**. Some are mere members and some are leaders. The condition of the Church is so bad that **if people claim that they only**

have saints in the Church, it only means that they are all tares. Can the Church accomplish her mission(Matthew 28:19,20) in her current condition, is she representing Christ the way He wants, as He is standing for her in the courts Above?

"The church has failed, **sadly failed, to meet the expectations of her Redeemer**, and yet the Lord does not withdraw Himself from His people."(LDE 58.2)

'The church has gone over to the world in transgression of the law, when the world should have come over to the church in obedience to the law. **Daily the church is being converted to the world.**"(COL 315.3)

Does this mean that Satan has succeeded in destroying the Church, that God's people will not occupy those angelic positions in the Heavenly courts? Though the condition of the Church is saddening, we are , **however assured that not only will judge first start at the house of God**(1 Peter 4:17), but also that the time will soon come when **"the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment,Nor sinners**

in the congregation of the righteous."(Psalms 1:5).

This work, the Bible calls the "Harvest".

"As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be **in the end of this world**. The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and **they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend**, and them which do iniquity; And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth."(Matthew 13:49-42)

This work is signified by the Earth swallowing(killing) the flood or waters(the Tares - Rev 12:16), **leaving the Woman, the Church, Pure - free from the Tares**. The same work of separation **is clearly brought to view in Ezekiel 9**. Inspiration also concurs these facts, by placing this work before the the close of probation and the latter rain in the following manner..

"The great issue so near at hand **will weed out those whom God has not appointed and he will have a pure, true, sanctified ministry prepared for the latter**

rain..."(3SM 385.3)

"But the days of purification of the church are hastening on apace. God will have a people pure and true. In the mighty sifting soon to take place we shall be better able to measure the strength of Israel. The signs reveal that the time is near when the Lord will manifest that His fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly purge His floor."(5T 79.4)

When this purifying work shall be completed, it shall come to pass that, "...only those who have withstood temptation in the strength of the Mighty One will be permitted to act a part in proclaiming it[The Third Angel's Message] when it shall have swelled into the loud cry."(RH,Nov 19, 1908)

Then it is that, **"Clad in the armor of Christ ' s righteousness, the church is to enter upon her final conflict. 'Fair as the moon, clear as the sun, and terrible as an army with banners' (Song of Solomon 6:10), she is to go forth into all the world, conquering**

and to conquer."(PK 725.2)

When the Church is thus purified and protected, Satan will be wroth with it and quickly go to make war with "the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ"(Revelation 12:17). And he will do so by making an Image to the Beast and the Sunday Law.

THE. CHURCH AS AN ANGEL OF THE LORD.

It's an interesting fact to see that the Lord will make his people, the Church without Tares in it, as an Angel before they are finally made equal with the angels at his coming.

"In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David shall be as God, as the angel of the LORD before them."(Zechariah 12:8)

Pointing to the time of "the mark of the beast", Inspiration says that, "**The most weak and hesitating in the church**

will be as David—willing to do and dare. The deeper the night for God's people, the more brilliant the stars. Satan will sorely harass the faithful; but, in the name of Jesus, **they will come off more than conquerors. Then will the church of Christ appear 'fair as the moon, clear as the sun, and terrible as an army with banners.'**

(5T 81.2)

So Jerusalem is the Church. Its inhabitants are Church members. Thus the Church will only conquer when the weakest in the Church become like David, like God and **like an angel of the Lord.** At that time of the mark of the beast, and of the Loud cry, the Church will be as strong as, **"his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word."**(Psalms 103:20)

"They raised the sword to kill us, but it broke, and fell as powerless as a straw."(EW 34.1)

"A fire devoureth before them; and behind them a flame burneth: the land is as the garden of Eden before them,

and behind them a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing shall escape them. **The appearance of them is as the appearance of horses; and as horsemen, so shall they run.**"(Joel 2:3-4)

"As the third angel's message swells into a loud cry, great power and glory will attend its proclamation. **The faces of God's people will shine with the light of heaven.**"(LDE 201.4)

"Servants of God, with their faces lighted up and shining with holy consecration, will hasten from place to place to proclaim the message from Heaven. By thousands of voices, all over the earth, the warning will be given. Miracles will be wrought, the sick will be healed, and signs and wonders will follow the believers. Satan also works with lying wonders, even bringing down fire from heaven in the sight of men. [Revelation 13:13.] Thus the inhabitants of the earth will be brought to take their stand."(GC88 612.1)

"For he will finish the work, and cut it short in

righteousness: because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth."(Romans 9:28)

In this way, the work of Redemption will be completed and Probation will close. Thus, shall the Church be made like the angel of the Lord before the inhabitants of the earth. Now your duty is clearly known, brother, sister. **You must be sealed, or you shall perish.**(Ezekiel 9:4-6). If you fail to get this Pure mark of Truth while mercy lingers, you won't get it later. To know Christ is to obey Him, and follow Him wherever he goes. Unless you do this, you will surely fall in the general destruction of the wicked. Now is the day of Salvation. **Get ready! Get ready!** My brother, my sister, can't you lift up your eyes and look unto heavens? We are standing on the borders of the eternal world. When the Work of the gospel closes, mercy no longer pleads, and the seven last plagues are poured out, the people of God will be ready to welcome Christ from heaven. **He will change our vile bodies and fashion them like unto His glorious body.** Will you be made equal with the angels of God? Will you be among those who will fill up the spaces left by the fallen angels
